**Dispositional Summary: REASON FOR DHS INVOLVEMENT:**

EPCDHS became involved with the Carter family due to concerns regarding physical abuse.

Javen Carter, age 2

Javen currently remains in his mother's care. He attends day care on Fort Carson at Child Development Center (CDC) North.

Deonte Carter (Biological father to Javen)

Mr. Carter is active duty Army. He has been removed from the family home and placed in the barracks.

Whitney Carter (Biological mother to Javen)

Mrs. Carter continues to live in family housing located on post. She appears protective and agrees to honor all court orders at this time.

**VISITATION:**


A referral has been completed to the Family Visitation Center. An assessment for trauma between Mr. Carter and Javen will be completed prior to the start of regular visitation.

**DHS SUMMARY:**

Both parents appear cooperative with all request made by the Department. A referral has been completed for Mr. Carter to receive services through the Family Center. Mrs. Carter will cooperate with the Nurturing Parent Program through Fort Carson. The Department will make a referral to the Kemp Center as to ask for a second opinion with respect to the injuries.

**Agency Recommendations:** It is respectfully recommended that:

Custody of Javen remains with Mrs. Carter with EPCDHS exercising protective supervision.
